It is an honor and privilege for me to have been elected as the President of Community Development Centre. I am humble and very grateful to Mr. Ameen Charles who proposed my name and all the members of the governing board for unanimously electing me and providing me with this opportunity.

The CDC is a non-profit organization founded by some enthusiastic youths led by Mr. Ameen Charles. Since its inception the organization has worked with diverse groups and people and implemented various programs and campaigns with the support of National and International organizations and individuals to achieve its ultimate goal of building a healthy, educated and empowered society where peace, justice and equal opportunities are available to all.

The past year has been a real joy for me as I have had the opportunity to interact with our grassroots staff and community participants who are the real change makers. What I have witnessed makes me even more excited about our future and the ways in which we can deepen our impact in the communities we serve. In the past two years, our major concern has been to empower the tribal community especially the Baigas in such a way that they can fulfill their basic needs without depending more on forests. Children have been our top priority keeping the fact in mind that 'Today's child is tomorrow's citizen'. Therefore, in implementation of the livelihood project and working with women panchayat representa-

tives, all our efforts have been in the direction of creating a better environment for the children. I am proud to report some highlights of our achievements and successes during the reporting period 2017-18. With support of Paul Hamlyn Foundation, CDC had initiated the Promotion of Sustainable Livelihood program among the tribal communities. There have been 322 direct beneficiary households of the programs. We have been successful in extending improved cropping practices like SRI. NADEP pits have been built by the beneficiary farmers who participated in the training on low cost composting. Training and distribution of good quality seeds resulted in increased income of about 100 beneficiary families who earned additional 60-65 thousand rupees per year through cultivation of turmeric, ginger, potato and vegetables leading to raise their living standard. CDC put its efforts to build capacities of women PRI representatives and due

to this, quite a few number of women representatives are now able to take their own decisions without any external influence and pressure. Mahila Jagruti Sangathan and Kisan Panchayat have become more accountable to the community and are actively involved in advocating on local issues. In the coming days, the organization has decided to focus its efforts further on strengthening women PRI members and building capacities of community members. We have planned to work for education and health care of Baiga children and want to implement ECCE (Early Childhood Care and Education) program. I am very much excited to continue serving as the President of Community Development Centre for the remaining term and looking forward to working with my board members and very enthusiastic, energetic staff for the good of our society. I thank you all those who partnered with us to make our work possible.

The livelihood project in protected forest area involving more 300 tribal households, very small initiatives with these tribal families,

there are smiling faces because of their livelihood security, families earning good income with cultivating high value crops. The another initiatives with women Panchayat representatives, after continue capacity building and motivation, these women representatives now taking responsibilities for development of their ward and panchayat, more than 270 wom-

en's are now organized and confident with dealing at block and district level officials, media and other stakeholders. Some good initiatives from the women representatives on safe panchayat, poshan baadi etc. All the efforts through the organization mainly strengthening community for ensuring child rights in this region.



The project is being supported by Paul Hamlyn Foundation, which is completing five effective years of working with more than 300 Gond and Baiga families in Garhi area of Baihar block of the district. Through the project there is very good impact on life of the targeted families. Basically project has been supported to ensure livelihood of families which lives close to protected forest area, The project ensure sustainable income of the families, through cultivation of ginger, turmeric and potato. We have promoted SRI on

traditional seeds, the SRI system has been introduced with these families on their local variety of seeds, all these initiatives helps environment and protection of bio-diversity and reducing pressure on forest. Through the project effective convergence with Govt. program and schemes, around 2.5 CR mobilized from the Govt. schemes for soil and water conservation activities, around 100 families now earning Rs. 55 to 60 thousands additional for the family, which has been using by families on good education

for the children, accessing health services, creating assets for making the life easy, children's getting good food and cloths. Women are now having some saving and cash availability through out the year, because of cash income in multiple time during the year by selling of green vegetables. Social relationship has been increases, collective efforts through Kisan Panchayat, they are doing positive advocacy on local issues and what they need.

Seed Support to the families & Income

Seed support is one of the core activity of the project which gives good support to families.

The project has taking an initiative to conserve local seeds, because of ownership on seeds and to keep safe marginalized farmers from market forces, there are lots of traditional seeds which extinct. Still there is different variety seeds which need to conserve. Making an effort by project team, they have collected 44 variety of paddy seeds and lots of vegetable seeds, which is good

for local climate and give good production. This year with the 10 BEEJ MITRA we are in process to multiply some seeds which is in stage of endanger. There is black paddy which is very rare species of paddy. We are trying for conserving this species, which is required for local bio-diversity. Similarly Jeera Phool is one of the very good variety of Paddy. We are promoting farmers to grow or-

ganic. If at this stage farmer not taking this type of steps they will not able to fight with market. We are not against the new improved seeds but there should be space for local and traditional seeds and farmers have control on it.



WHY CHOSEN TURMERIC (HALDI) CROP ?


- Turmeric crop cultivation duration is from June to March end, means in rainy season no more irrigation required.

- Soil at project location suitable for turmeric cultivation.








Emerging Leaders in Panchayat

Women leadership is one of the core issue of work of the organization. In 2015 with the partnership of The Hunger Project, the project for elected women representatives has been initiated in Baihar block of Balaghat district. It was different program of leadership among women panchayat representatives. It was not just training program for elected women representatives but it is promoting women for their political leadership journey. In 2018 we have completed fourth year of the project, a strong federation of elected

women representatives has been formed and working in the area for different issues of development, women safety, education, malnutrition, sanitation, housing etc. CDC is working with 276 women representatives, with in very limited space of work for Panch and sarpanch in Panchayat these women representatives has been found their space to work for community. The elected women representatives now working very much confidently, demanding, discussing and raising issues among Govt. officials. Through vari-

ous level training and orientation the project has give opportunity to learn these women's who are from tribal communities, weaker section. There are more than 50 emerging leaders in this area which will move forward with development agenda and fulfill the needs of people. Women in Panchayat playing effective role in Panchayat meeting, Gram Sabha and putting their own agenda as per need of the community. It was first time in this area who worked very closely with elected women representatives.

Women safety is most important issue at every level, After forming of Jagriti Mahila Jan Pratinidi Sangathan, the federation members facilitating and running campaign on women safety. The campaign violence against women has been effectively implementing by federation members every year. They have done safety audit in 10 panchayat in 2017 and now trying to make these panchayat safe for women and girls.

These elected members working on malnutrition issue in different approach, After getting training on child malnutrition and anemia, they have promoted families to grow Poshan Badi at Home, These Poshan Badi has been grown at the home where malnourished children's or pregnant women is anemic or having children and adolescents. Each EWR has worked with at least 10

families and promoted them to grow and consume green vegetables at home. The EWR's continue visiting Anganwadi centers, not for monitoring but supporting to the Anganwadi workers on Nutrition and Health Day, Immunization day, Supporting AWW to send children NRC. Mobilizing families for proper and routine growth monitoring of children's at the center. Anganwadi work-

er also happy to get the help of EWR and they are able to bring issues in Gram Sabha related to nutrition and health services.

Home, and schools is also not safe some time. There is need to make aware of each children. Every child is important for the society and the nation. There is need to prepare more positive environment for children's. CDC is trying to work more effectively on this issue, not only in the district but also in region. We have partnering with

AAWAJ Bhopal for program on Child Protection, Its an issue need to learn everyone. Today there are different acts, rules and regulations for children, but still there is unaware community, parents and most important children. Need to make more child friendly community. We are focusing in very remote and tribal areas for making awareness and regular making dialogue with rural community for child safety.

CDC has been completed three years to run childline project in the district, this project is being implement with very close coordination and supports of different Govt. Departments, mainly Women & Child Development, Police, CWC, Health, Education and other allied department. In last three years, through the project the team has been worked more than 600 cases related to children's. We are raising awareness on toll free num-

ber 1098 among children and the society. The project team making outreach daily and discussing with community, parents and most important children's.

Childhood is in danger, this need to understand, there is crime against children in every minute in our society. Missing of children is one of the most common problem in our society but , this need to think why our children's are missing ? And there is

big numbers of missing children, who never found. CDC is continue trying to sensitize community on child issues. CHILDLINE is very big network in India which gives hope to children's.

EMBED : Elimination of Mosquito Borne Endemic Disease

The project EMBED started with the support of Godrej and Family Health India (FHI) in the month of Nov. 2017. In this project we are covering 119 villages of Baihar, Birsa and Paraswada block of the district. There 119 villages identified on the basis of API (Annual Parasitic Index), the data has been taken from office of District Malaria Officer. Primarily village profiling, social mapping has been done in first quarter of the project. The project is based on behavior change, through the different project activities. Mainly

ECCE (Early Childhood Care and Education)

Organization is working on implementation of ECCE in rural tribal areas. ECCE is new subject for community, School teachers, Anganwadi worker etc. Govt. of MP has decided to implement ECCE through WCD. District and block level ECCE coordinator has been appointed by the department, but the issue is about knowledge and perception. CDC has organized state level advocacy meeting with different organization and memorandum has been provided to minister of WCD and other high level authorities who are responsible to

implement ECCE. At the field level need to work more with ECCE providers, need to nicely orient staffs who is dealing with children and most important, this is the issue need to be discuss with parents. It is required to work on Mother tongue based learning, need to focus on local dialect or language. The available material on ECCE is in Hindi but no material available in regional language. Need to work on local language. We are collecting information on local language in our working area. Most of the tribal area is

being covered by Hindi. There is need to incorporate Gondi language words in publication and other reading materials.



State level consultation on ECCE

Utkarsh Vidhyalaya, Garhi

CDC runs this school in a tribal village, the school is now get recognize for high school. Since its establishment the school is continue providing good education to children's of tribal and other weaker community.

School has provided opportunity to 13 teachers to complete D.L.Ed. from NIOS, the teachers who are serving in schools since long time. We believe on capacity building of teacher's, this year three

days residential training organized for teachers on how to improve skills on developing learning materials. In school we focus on how to make education interactive and enjoyable. Our school gives space to student to discuss on all matters, issues and try to learn by act. Schools provides all the basic facilities to our students in school. We have created very child friendly environment in school, school is not only for study

but it gives recreations and fun to children; every year we discuss with students on various issues like child rights, gender, safety, child abuse etc. etc. We are giving full opportunity to weaker section through implementation of RTE. In partnership with Armor Education Group, practical based learning implementing in the school. More easy learning and education tools from Global Shiksha has been arranged by the school for students.

Education support to children

CDC is providing educational supports to youths and children who are doing good in study. College fee and coaching fee has been provided to two students and 69 school students, whose fee has been provided by the organization, Students who are studying in our school and unable to pay fee of the school, who are from BPL family or any other reason. We are trying to provide sup-

port to children. We are collecting resources for individual donors, members of the organization. Along with this we are providing school uniform, books, school bag etc.

जिले में बाल श्रमिकों की पहचान, विमुक्ति व पुनर्वास के लिए गठित जिला स्तरीय टास्क फोर्स की बैठक सोमवार को कलेक्टर डीवी सिंह की अध्यक्षता में आयोजित की गई। उक्त बैठक में अपर जिला मजिस्ट्रेट, श्रम नवाधिकारी, जिला बाल संरक्षण अधिकारी, महिला बाल विकास अधिकारी, जिला शिक्षा अधिकारी, जिला खाद्य अधिकारी, स्वैच्छिक संगठन के प्रतिनिधि, जिला नोडल अधिकारी (श्रम निरीक्षक) व अन्य अधिकारी मौजूद रहे। संशोधनों की दी जानकारी -बैठक में बाल श्रम अधिनियम 2016 में हुए संशोधनों की विस्तृत जानकारी प्रदान करते हुये, बताया गया कि बाल श्रम एक अत्यन्त संवेदनशील विषय है। समस्त व्यवसाय व संस्थानों में बाल श्रम अर्थात 14 वर्ष तक के बालकों के कार्य करने पर प्रतिबंधित किया गया है। बाल श्रमिकों को कार्य में नहीं रखने के सख्त निर्देश दिए गए हैं। इसके साथ ही कुमार अर्थात 14 वर्ष से अधिक लेकिन 18 वर्ष से कम आयु के कुमार श्रमिकों को खदान, ज्वलनशील व कारखाना अधिनियम के अन्तर्गत खतरनाक प्रक्रियाओं में कार्य करने पर अधिनियम के अंतर्गत पूर्णतः प्रतिबंधित किया गया है। जिले के समस्त ग्रामीण व शहरी क्षेत्रों के समस्त संस्थानों व स्थापनाओं में नियोजित किए जाने वाले बाल व कुमार श्रमिकों की पहचान कर उनकी विमुक्ति व पुनर्वास के लिए कार्रवाई करने के निर्देश दिए हैं। कार्रवाई जारी-बैठक में जौड़ी गुप्ता श्रम अधिकारी ने बताया गया कि, टास्क फोर्स की 27 नवंबर 2017 की बैठक में दिए गए निर्देशों के अनुरूप जिले में ग्रामीण व शहरी क्षेत्रों के औचक निरीक्षण के लिए श्रम विभाग, महिला व बाल विकास विभाग, विशेष पुलिस इकाई, चाईल्ड लाईन बालाघाट के संयुक्त दल का गठन कर बाल श्रम प्रथा को रोकने जाने की कार्रवाई निरन्तर का जा रही है। निरीक्षण के दौरान जिले में कोई भी बाल श्रमिक कार्यरत नहीं पाए गए हैं।

In small town and cities there is demand for committed, educated and well groomed youths or supporting hands, Availability of good man power is always problem, another important thing is trust on the workers. The same thing apply for employee, they have always question about

their wages, is the wages timely paid by employer or not, if the employee is absent, than the wages will be cut, sometime, misbehave with employee etc. there is lots of reason which creates problem for both, employee and employer.

Through this program we are planning to map human resources in rural areas who need part-time or full time employment. Than these youths, person will be train on basic soft skills and skills on demand. The employer also will be educated on basic rights on employee and mainly on fare wages and timely pay-
