

## Covid-19 Relief Work

The sudden lock down due to the covid-19 epidemic created a lot of problems, the problem of food grains arose with the families in rural tribal areas within a few days. The field staff kept an eye on these situations and the team of the organization did the planning together and on the basis of the primary survey, the needy families were identified. Efforts were made to arrange resources for providing food grains to the needy families and with the help of different agencies, individual donors, assistance was provided to about 3000 families and more than 400 children.

## Food kits distribution

In 55 villages of Baihar block, 3000 families, mainly tribal, single women, differently abled, women headed families, pregnant women were provided ration kits for one to two months, in which rice, flour, pulses, oil, soybeans, spices, potatoes , Onion etc. were provided.

## Nutrition kit to pregnant women

Nutrition kits were provided to pregnant and lactating women, which included lentils, soybeans, oil, groundnut, jaggery, murmura, as well as training women on better use of nutrition kits keeping in mind the covid protocol.

## Coverage

- Ration kit to Baiga and Gond (Tribe) 2200 families
- Nutrition supply to 200 street connected children's for 6 months.
- Mask, sanitizer, soap distributed to 450 school going children's
- Nutrition kit to 100 pregnant women's
- Interest free loan to 200 women for income generation activity

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## Income Generation Activities ensure livelihood

After a long lock down, many sources of livelihood and income generation in rural areas were closed, at this time it was necessary to start afresh employment, CDC provided 200 women an interest free amount of ten to twenty thousand, so that women Started small jobs and made some income for their family every day, women started businesses like grocery, food grains, hotels, poultry, milk business, tailoring, cloth business, general stores, kiosks, today all women Trying to grow business. In this critical situation the women worked without getting discouraged and took care of the family through income generating activity for their family. Our field staff also constantly kept in touch with women and encouraged, provided support at every level, which kept the enthusiasm among women.

## Nutrition to street connected children’s

During this pandemic, we have employed more than 200 children who are somehow connected by roads, beggars or garbage collectors. It was necessary to protect them from any kind of infection as well as to provide food and supplementary nutrition. We provided nutrition to these children for 6 months, tried to connect them with education, apart from this some training was also provided in which making decoration material from paper mesh. More than 35 children were connected to the theater in which children learned acting and demonstrated their art. Even in the present time, children are connected with us.

Mohalla class was conducted to keep 350 tribal children of Garhi area connected with primary education and nutritious laddus were also provided to these children.
